

## Case Study: New Terrace for St Helena Hospice



St Helena Hospice provides a range of inpatient, outpatient, home and hospital care for people with life limiting illnesses in Essex.

As well as their 15 bed in patient unit, the Hospice also runs two therapy and wellbeing centres and provides education, training and research for professionals working in palliative and end of life care.
